When inside you will be greeted by a member of our TechFest team. You will hand them your money on the way in and in return they will give you a wristband




You don't have to wear the wristband if you don't want to, you can keep it in your pocket.




## Once you've passed the reception, the fun begins!

During the shows there may be parts which are quite loud, but don't worry you will be warned before it happens and nothing can hurt you.




If anything at our Activity Weekend is too loud then you are welcome to put your hands over your ears or take headphones with you to wear.
